

City Of Brandon Citywide Clean-Up Day

Who can drop off materials at the site?

Residents of the City of Brandon only. No waste from businesses, contractors, or those residing outside Brandon city limits will be accepted.

What materials are accepted?

- General non-hazardous household waste
- Furniture (couches, chairs, tables, mattresses, box springs, etc)
- Small amounts of remodeling materials (siding, dried out paint cans, drywall, carpet, etc.)
- Appliances (washers, dryers, dishwashers, hot water heaters, furnaces, heat pumps, garbage disposals, trash compactors, microwaves, ovens, ranges, stoves, window air conditioners, de-humidifiers, refrigerators, and freezers)
- Tires (Up to five tires per household accepted at no cost; \$5.00 disposal fee required for each additional tire; tires must be removed from rims and clean)

What materials are not accepted?

- Asbestos
- Batteries
- Chemical products
- Computer Monitors
- Herbicides & pesticides
- Florescent tubes & light bulbs
- Hazardous, industrial, and infectious waste
- Liquid wastes
- Paints and thinners
- Oils and oil rags
- Radioactive materials
- TV's
- Yard waste (includes grass clippings, leaves, trees and shrubs)

Where do I drop off my materials?

Trash and other debris can be placed in the dumpster located in the fire station parking lot between the hours of 8:00 AM and noon on Saturday, May 16th, 2026. Appliances and metal can be placed in a separate container at the same location.
